

COVID SERVICES SCHEME RULES

RECIPIENT ORGANISATION (RO) OBLIGATIONS

- 1 The RO will only seek to redeem one unique access code;
- 2 The RO will only enter into a contract with the Covid Services Supplier which has been allocated to it by IASME;
- 3 the RO warrants the Eligibility Criteria answers it supplies (via the website application form) are complete and accurate;
- 4 In the event that the RO supplies incomplete or inaccurate information in its responses to the Eligibility Criteria (via the website application form) or fails to comply with any of its other obligations under this scheme, it shall be liable to return to IASME, on demand, the full value of the relevant access code.
- 5 The RO will treat its involvement in the scheme as confidential unless otherwise agreed in writing with IASME.
- 6 The RO acknowledges and accepts that the Covid Services will be provided to it by a Covid Services Supplier and not by IASME and that IASME shall (to the fullest extent permitted by law) have no liability to the RO for the services it receives from the Covid Services Supplier and accordingly the RO shall make no claim against IASME, its directors ,servants, contractors, staff or agents.
- 7 The law of England and Wales shall apply to this agreement and the parties submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
- 8 The RO shall not do or cause or permit to be done anything that would damage the reputation or standing of IASME or the scheme.
- 10 The RO acknowledges that the unique access code cannot be redeemed for its notional or any cash value.
- 11 The RO gives permission for their business contact details to be shared with the Covid Service Provider nominated to deliver the required Package(s)
